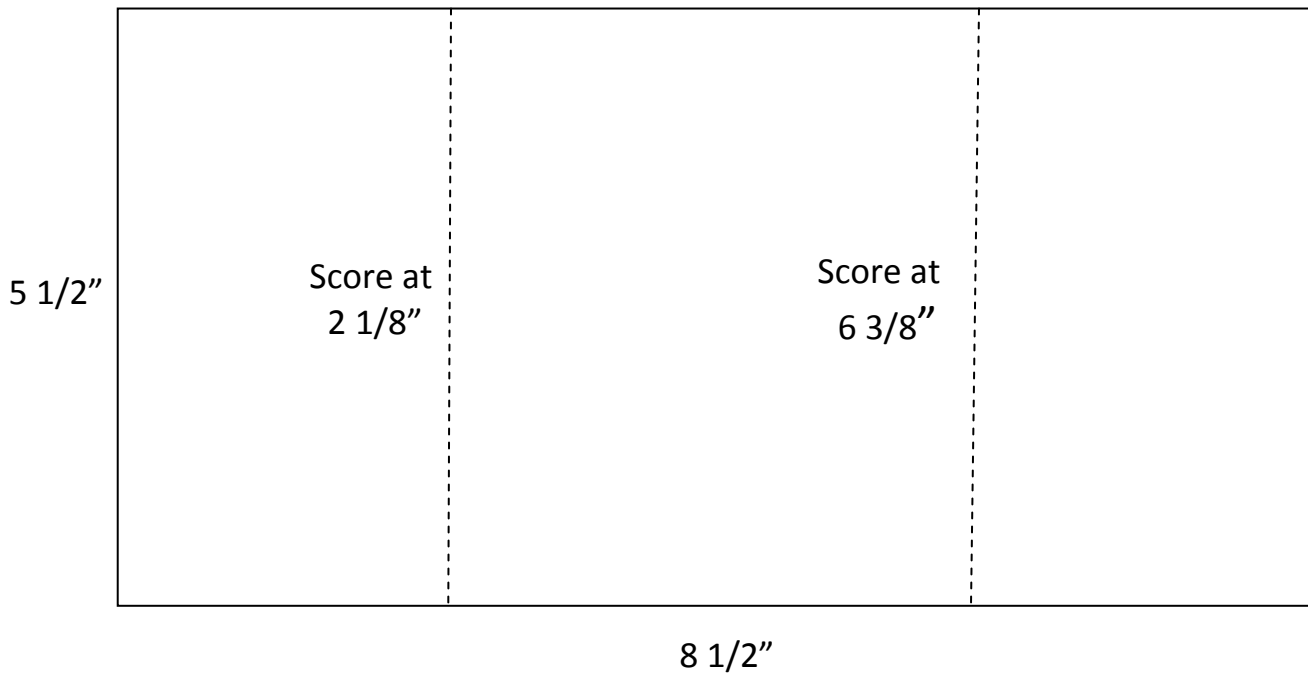


# Thanks A Latte Gate Fold Card

## Card Dimensions:

- Pear Pizzazz Card base 5 1/2" x 8 1/2", score at 2 1/8" and 6 3/8"
- Scrap pieces of Whisper White cardstock
- Scrap piece of Early Espresso cardstock
- Coffee Break Designer Series Paper 5 1/4' x 1 7/8" (cut 2)

## Supplies:

- Coffee Café Set #143677 \$21.00
- Coffee Cups Framelits #143745 \$30.00
- Coffee Café Bundle #145331 \$45.75 (save 10% by buying the set and dies together!)
- Corrugated Elements #144158 \$3.50
- Coffee Break Designer Series Paper #144155 \$11.00
- Coffee Break Cardstock Pack #144156 \$8.00
- Early Espresso Ink #126974 \$6.50
- Pear Pizzazz Ink #131180 \$6.50
- Linen Thread #104199 \$4.50
- Multipurpose Glue #110755 \$4.00
- Dimensionals \$104430 \$4.00
- Big Shot #143263 \$110.00

## Directions:

1. Fold the card base on score lines, use a bone folder for nice sharp creases.
2. Attach the Polka Dot DSP to each panel.
3. Stamp the large cup and lid using Early Espresso and the oval saying with Pear Pizzazz on the scrap Whisper White cardstock.
4. Cut out each image using the Coffee Cup Framelits
5. Cut the coffee collar from the Early Espresso cardstock using the fluted framelit.
6. Attach the lid and coffee collar to the cup with a small amount of Multipurpose Liquid Glue.
7. The oval saying was adhered to the oval Corrugated Element and attached using a dimensional.
8. Tie a strand of linen thread around the top then into a small bow.
9. The coffee cup gets attached to the left side only. This is very important so the card can open and close.
